I would like to share a few thoughts with you from our new Adult Bible Study theme, "25 Ways To Win With People." This new study will begin very soon. We meet regularly every Sunday morning from 8:15-9:15 a.m. Join us as we discuss, learn and study based on the Word of God.

Here are some thoughts from this study.

- Your relationships can only be as healthy as you are. Good relationships begin with knowing who we are.
- All of us have anxieties and certain insecurities. The decisive thing is what we do with them?

The knowledge that we gain about ourselves can turn sour or turn good.

- Being a "winner" comes down to one thingunderstanding our value and the value of others around us.
- Have we owned our value? The Scripture from John 3 describes the great value that God has placed upon us.

Here are few ways of owning and understanding our value...

- **RECOGNIZE** your value. No matter where we have been, what we have done or where we stand right now... we don't lose our value in God's sight. Just as long as we turn to Him and ask him to forgive, heal and restore us.
- ACCEPT your value despite the fact that we all have what we and others call 'issues'. These Issues are real and we have to work on them with the guidance and the help of God.
- INCREASE your value. We are a diamond in the rough ...God keeps shaping us into a gem. We don't stand still as Christians. We desire to maximize and fix and change the things that need changing.
- **BELIEVE** in your value, God already does.

REMEMBER: Our relationships can only be as healthy as we ourselves.


The New Home! (02-01-2018)


The Final payment for the retreat will be due April 4th.



Memory Garden and Walkways Do you know we have them?

I have been a member here for over 27 years and would like to talk about our Memory Garden and its walkways which are located to the left of the Church, in between the two buildings. It was started by the church when Pastor Richard Merrick's beloved wife Sarah passed away suddenly and the Garden was created, named and dedicated to her memory.

The Garden is a place where Ashes can be placed when a loved one dies. Their name goes on the Memorial Plaque hanging on the side wall of the Sanctuary. A fee of \$150 is charged for placement of the ashes in the Garden and the name on the plaque (or just the name on the plaque if you don't wish to place the ashes). If you would like more information about this, please call the church office and ask to speak with Patti. The fee is used to provide Perpetual Care of the Memory Garden.

The garden has changed over the years as storms such as Hurricane Irma have created some damage. My family and I redesigned the Garden several years ago and put in the brick walkways.

We have two walkways: The first was put in to honor church members and their families, either past or present. The second walkway was added to honor military veterans, police officers and firefighters who risk their lives protecting us.

I invite you to buy a brick and help us to continue the tradition! Bricks are \$50 each and they are sold at any time. Please see the display in the Narthex. I painted a picture of the Garden and it is hanging in the Narthex as part of the display.

The process is simple and easy – pick up a form, fill in what you want on the brick. You are allowed up to 3 lines with a maximum of 14 letters or spaces per line. Submit your form with a \$50 check made payable to the church. The bricks are ordered and when they come in, they are placed in the appropriate walkway.

So, again, I invite you to consider buying a brick to help us continue the tradition!


Also, "Evidence for Christianity: Historical Evidence for the Christian Faith" by Josh McDowell is a book that answers many doubts Christians have.






From the Church Mouse.....




