The Spirit of the LORD has told me what to say. (2 Samuel 23:2)

Dear Church Family,

On the official church calendar, 50 days after the resurrection of Christ comes Pentecost. The outpouring of God's Holy Spirit upon the believer and the very birth of the Church. The truth is, for us as Christians it is always Pentecost.

The words from the book of Samuel are the last words of King David. T hey speak of the Holy Spirit. This great King who knew that the LORD was his shepherd knew the LORD as his guide. As a King he had accomplished many great things and yet this is what his last words are about.

The Spirit of the LORD has told me what to say. (2 Samuel 23:2)

Here we see the Holy Spirit already in the Old Testament but in the New Testament all believers have the Holy Spirit living within them. We need the Holy Spirit to show us the way. Think of the Apostle Paul and the guidance he received on his missionary journey. It is recorded for us in Acts 16:6:

Next Paul and Silas traveled through the area of Phrygia and Galatia, because the Holy Spirit had prevented them from preaching the word in the province of Asia at that time.

It is an exciting fact that as Christians we receive guidance in such a practical and concrete way, if we just ask. We need, as individuals and as the Church, this leading of the Holy Spirit on a daily basis; so we walk through life with open eyes, a receptive heart and rise up for action where action is needed.

Let's give thanks as Pentecost approaches that the Holy Spirit is the Comforter and great Helper, so we would notice and see and act when others need our help. The world needs the Church and the believer to be alert.

But the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengthener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name (in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf), He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.




