In the process they and we ourselves will find assurance once again in the truth that the good work which God has started in them and us, HE will also finish and complete. Let us be encouraged today in this truth of the Bible, it is addressed to us!







Remember the 2nd Sunday is our Collection of Food for those who are hungry. We alternate months, going to Salvation Army and Face of Hope.



New to the library is "Vanishing Grace" by Philip Yancey. In his earlier book "What's So Amazing about Grace?" (also on the shelf), the author issued a call for Christians

to be as grace-filled in their behavior as they are in declaring their beliefs. He now returns to this vital subject, asking why Christians continue to lose respect, influence, and reputation in our modern culture. Yet people everywhere still thirst for grace. How can Christians present truly Good News amid the changing landscapes of our time? The author explores how grace can bridge the gap between Christian faith and a world increasingly suspicious of it.

Also new is "*The Lost Books of the Bible*". Although they were not included in the New Testament, the beautifully written stories are an excellent source of early thought and expansion.

"When 'Spiritual But Not Religious' Is not Enough" by Lillian Daniel was one of the books discussed by the adult Sunday School Class. Humorous and sincere, this is a book about people finding God in the most unexpected places.


