Dear Church Family,

We have by now entered a new and a very busy season in the life of our church. We have a beautiful church and place of worship we are privileged to enjoy every Sunday and for many other activities throughout the week. The place of worship for the people of Israel after they left slavery in Egypt was the TABERNACLE.

As a people they had to learn what it meant to live in freedom. The tabernacle would remain their place of worship for some 500 years. We can learn so much from the rich symbolism and the intricate details of its design, which was revealed to Moses upon the mountain. Two things stand out to me right now. The seven armed lampstand (which stood in the center) was to remind the worshiper as he was drawing near to GOD that GOD IS LIGHT, always! So in a sense when we light the candles at the beginning of our worship service we are reminded too about this attribute of our God.

The other thing that stands out is what Hebrews 11 speaks about when it states "We must draw near to God in Faith." Here are some thoughts about faith.

- Faith means we are trusting God when we don't know our next step or the step after that. Keeping in mind that the one who has given the promise and the one who has said HE would never leave us is completely TRUSTWORTHY. We see the promises fulfilled in Abraham's life but only after he believed beyond all logic, when it didn't make sense.
- <u>Faith carries us!</u> <u>Faith helps us overcome fears.</u> Watch what will take place when faith spreads itself out in our lives instead of fear.
- <u>Faith rescues us!</u> However, it is sad if we only know this side of faith. When we take faith as a sort of last resort or last solution.
- Faith is our reply to GOD calling us! We reply because the message has hit us right into the heart and center. It matters what God thinks about us and we respond to his calling.
- <u>Faith leads us to come closer to God!</u> That is once more the goal we will pursue as we enter this new season in the life of the church. Drawing in faith near to God, to get to know Him more and more and to make Him known.
